

## Student Right-to-Know Act

According to regulations published by the Department of Education based on the Student Right-to-Know Act (SRTK), the SRTK Graduation Rate is described as follows:

It is based upon students who entered as full-time, first-time freshmen and graduated with 150% of the length of their program.

**These rates are the graduation/completion data from Sumner College.** The graduation/completion rates for the cohort of first-time, full-time students who entered school in full year cohort 2013-2014 who graduated/completed within 150 percent of the normal time to complete the longest program:
