



VOTER REGISTRATION

VOTER ELIGIBILITY

- **REQUIREMENTS TO VOTE:**

1. Must be at least 18 years of age (you can register at 17, but you will not be able to vote until an election falls on or after you turn 18)
2. You must be a United States Citizen
3. Must be an Oregon resident and have registered to vote in the state within 21 days before the election day.

VOTER REGISTRATION PROCESS

- **ONLINE:**

To register to vote online, please visit <https://secure.sos.state.or.us/orestar/vr/register.do>.

- **BY MAIL:**

You can receive a Voter Registration Form online at <http://sos.oregon.gov/elections/Documents/SEL500.pdf>. Once you fill out the form, please mail it to the correct County Elections Office; address is found on the back of your registration form. You can also pick up a voter registration form at state or local election offices, the DMV, public library, city office, county clerk's office, and public schools.

- **IN PERSON:**

VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE

- **DEADLINE:**

The deadline to register to vote is 21 days before Election Day.
